Investment Objective and Policy Summary

The Fund seeks to achieve capital growth and income with an above median level of volatility (risk), having a risk profile of 5, in a range from 1 to 7, where 1 is the lowest risk and 7 the highest.

The Fund is an actively managed fund of funds which invests at least 70% of its assets in other funds (underlying funds), including those traded on stock exchanges, other closed-ended funds and funds managed by Architas or its associates. The underlying funds will invest in a range of asset classes including shares, bonds, money market instruments, freely transferable rights to buy other investments at a future date (warrants), financial contracts that derive their value from other investments or indices (derivatives) and deposits.

The underlying funds will where practicably possible be 'active' funds, which are funds that aim to beat the performance of various


financial indices. The Fund may also invest directly in the above asset classes. The Fund may invest indirectly in property through Real Estate Investment Trusts and shares in property investment companies. The Fund aims to take an above median high level of risk. The investments are combined together in different proportions by Architas based on risk profiles set by an external risk modelling company (EValue Investment Solutions).

EValue assigns each combination of assets to one of seven risk profiles, ranging from 1 to 7. The Fund has a risk profile 5, which means it will typically have a greater exposure to higher risk assets.

The EValue model is different to that used to generate the Risk and Reward Indicator shown in this document, so the two rankings may differ.

COMMENTARY

September was the worst month for stocks (equities) since March, as governments battled to keep their economies running while tackling an upswing in Covid-19 infection rates. The US stock market had a poor month, as a combination of investor profit taking and election uncertainty dragged the S&P 500 lower.

The European and UK stock markets both fell, as new lockdown measures were implemented in several regions. Global government bond prices were broadly higher in September, as they tend to be when investors' appetite for riskier assets takes a hit. Corporate bonds, high yield bonds and emerging market debt were all lower over the month. The US dollar rose against its global counterparts, and the euro had a mixed month, while sterling fell against other major currencies. In September, the Progressive fund's fixed income allocation rose slightly. We increased exposure to UK government bonds through the Vanguard UK Long Duration Gilt Index and iShares UK Gilt All

Stocks Index Funds, but also reduced our holdings in the Robeco Global Credit and Vanguard UK Investment Grade Bond Index Funds. Within equities, we substantially reduced exposure to the UK by trimming our holdings in the Evenlode Income and Artemis Income Funds. We also reduced our US allocation to a lesser extent, by trimming the Selection US Equity and AB American growth Funds, while increasing exposure to European equities. There was also a change to the fund's property exposure, as we sold the remainder of our position in the F&C Commercial Property Trust.



Fund of Funds - Liquidity Risk: The Fund invests in other funds. Its liquidity depends upon those funds. If they suspend or defer the payment of redemption proceeds, the Fund's ability to meet redemption requests may also be affected.

Derivatives Risk: Derivatives are used in an attempt to reduce risk or for investment purposes. Use of derivatives could cause share prices to fluctuate which may result in the Fund suffering a loss.

Currency Risk: The value of the Fund may fall or rise as a result of changes in exchange rates from overseas investments.

Emerging Markets: Less economically developed markets can involve greater risks than well developed markets. For example, political unrest and economic downturn may be more likely and could affect the Fund value. IMPORTANT INFORMATION

The charge is expressed as a percentage per annum but is normally taken daily from the fund and is calculated based on the value of funds under management. Normally the fund manager reserves the right to review the level of charge.

The Ongoing Charges Figure (OCF), is a charge you'll pay over a year for as long as you hold your investment, it is made up of the Annual Management Charge (AMC) and other operating costs. Other charges may occur; full details can be found within our Fund Charges Factsheets at architas.com

primarily the level of exposure to shares / equities. The funds in the sector will not have exactly the same characteristics (such as their objectives, level of risk and types of risk) and are therefore not an exact like-for-like comparison.
